How to downgrade an iPhone 4 CDMA



What you need to downgrade firmware:

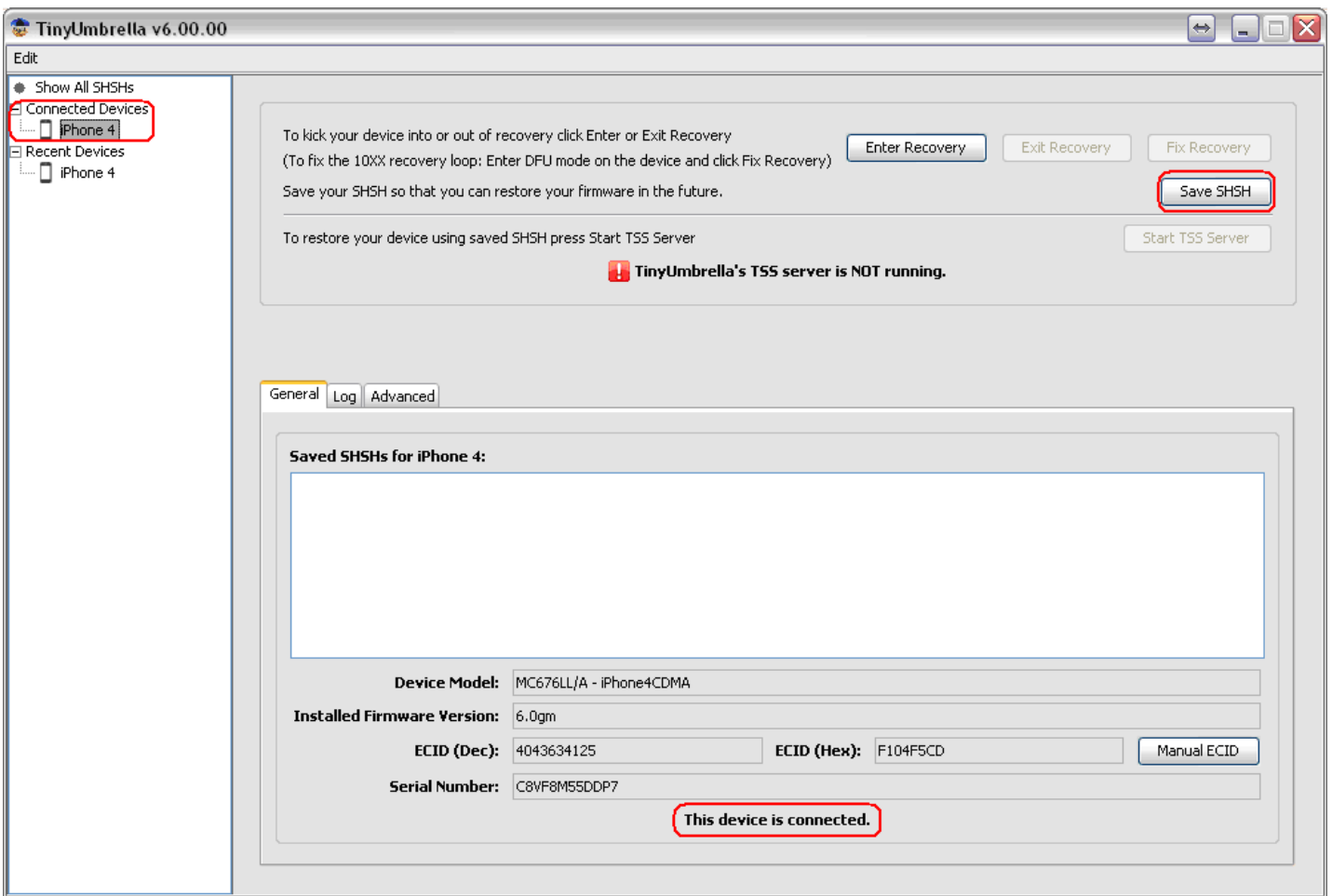
Download [TinyUmbrella](#)

Download [sn0wbreeze](#)

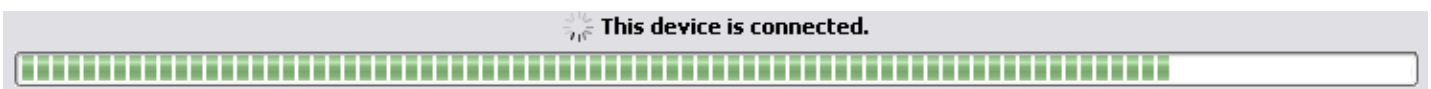
Download [iOS 5.1.1](#) for iPhone 4 CDMA (iPhone3,3_5.1.1_9B206_Restore.ipsw)

Step 1: Save SHSH

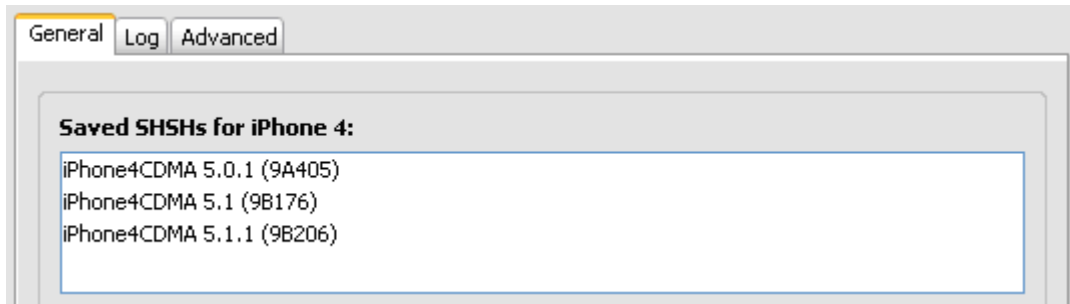
Connect Apple
Run **TinyUmbrella**



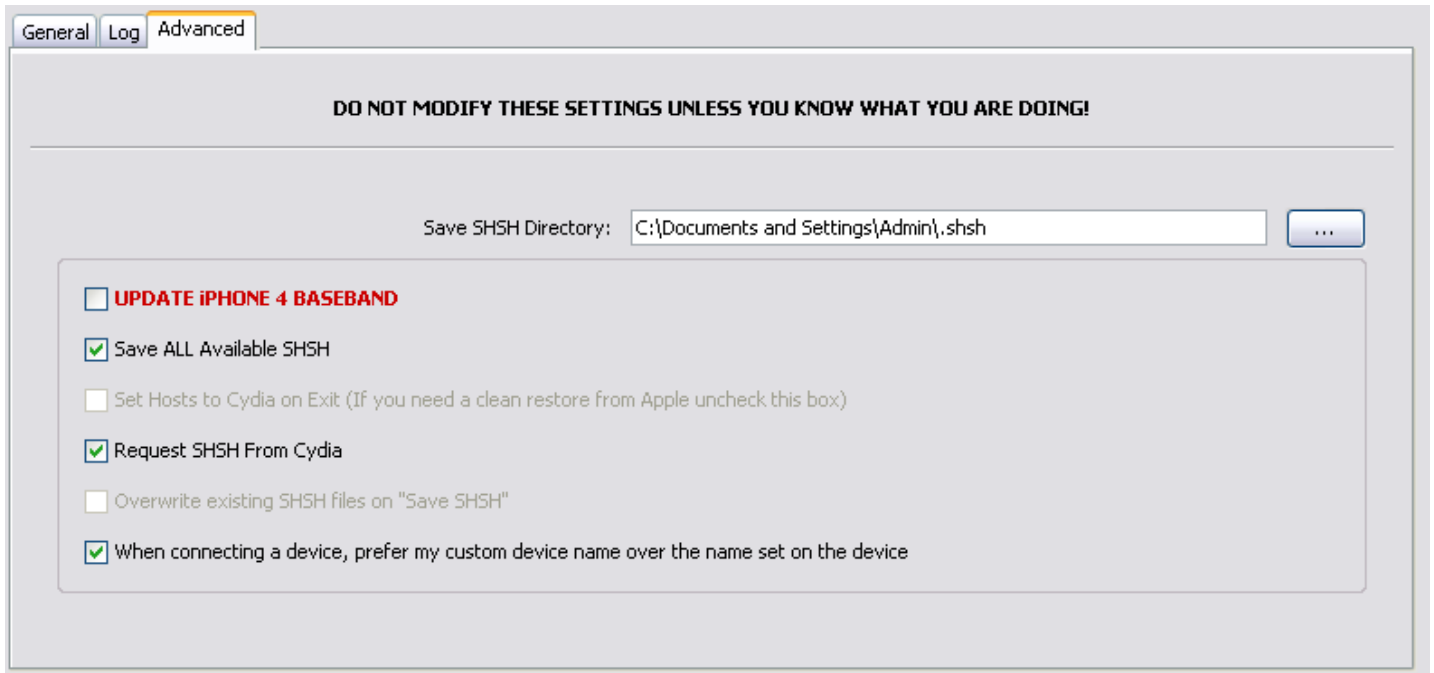
Choose «**Connected Devices**» and press the «**Save SHSH**»

The certificates **SHSH** are saved in the specified place in the settings:

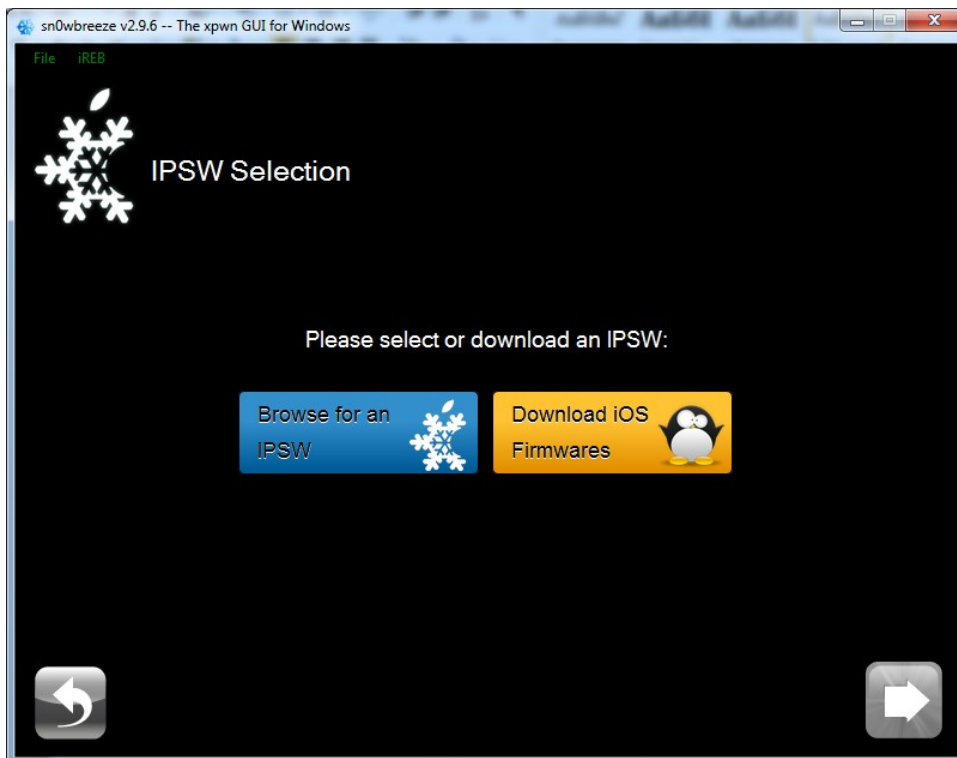


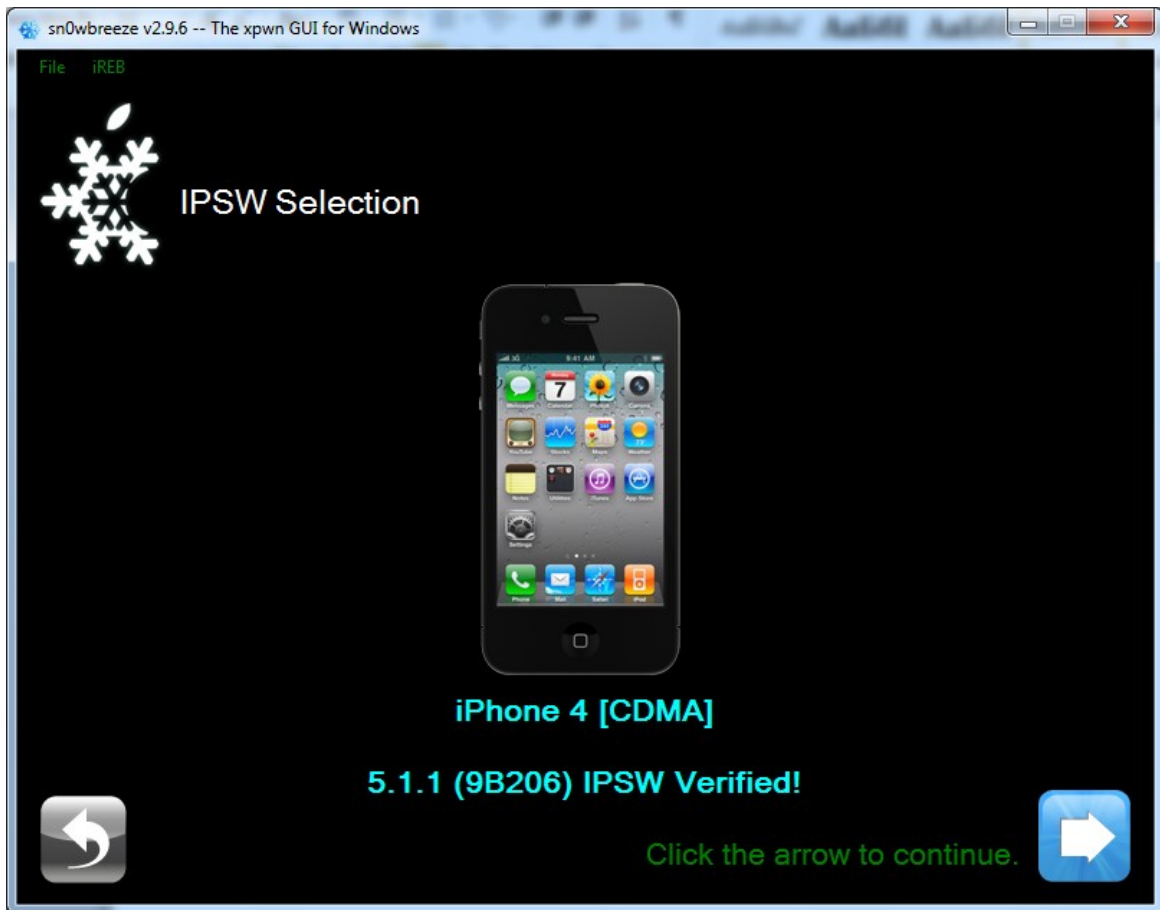
Step 2: Create custom FW

Run **sn0wbreeze**

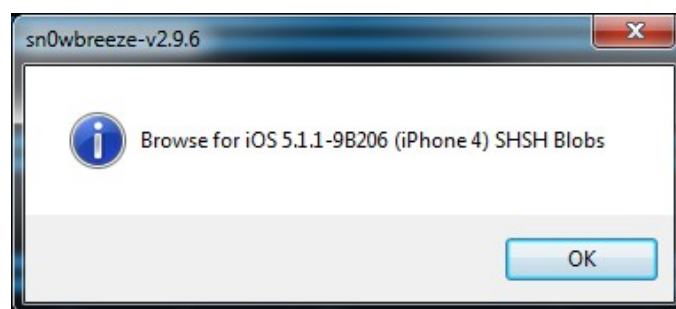


Browse for an **IPSW 5.1.1 (iPhone3,3_5.1.1_9B206_Restore.ipsw)**



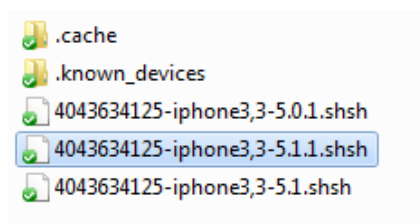


Select **iFaith Mode**



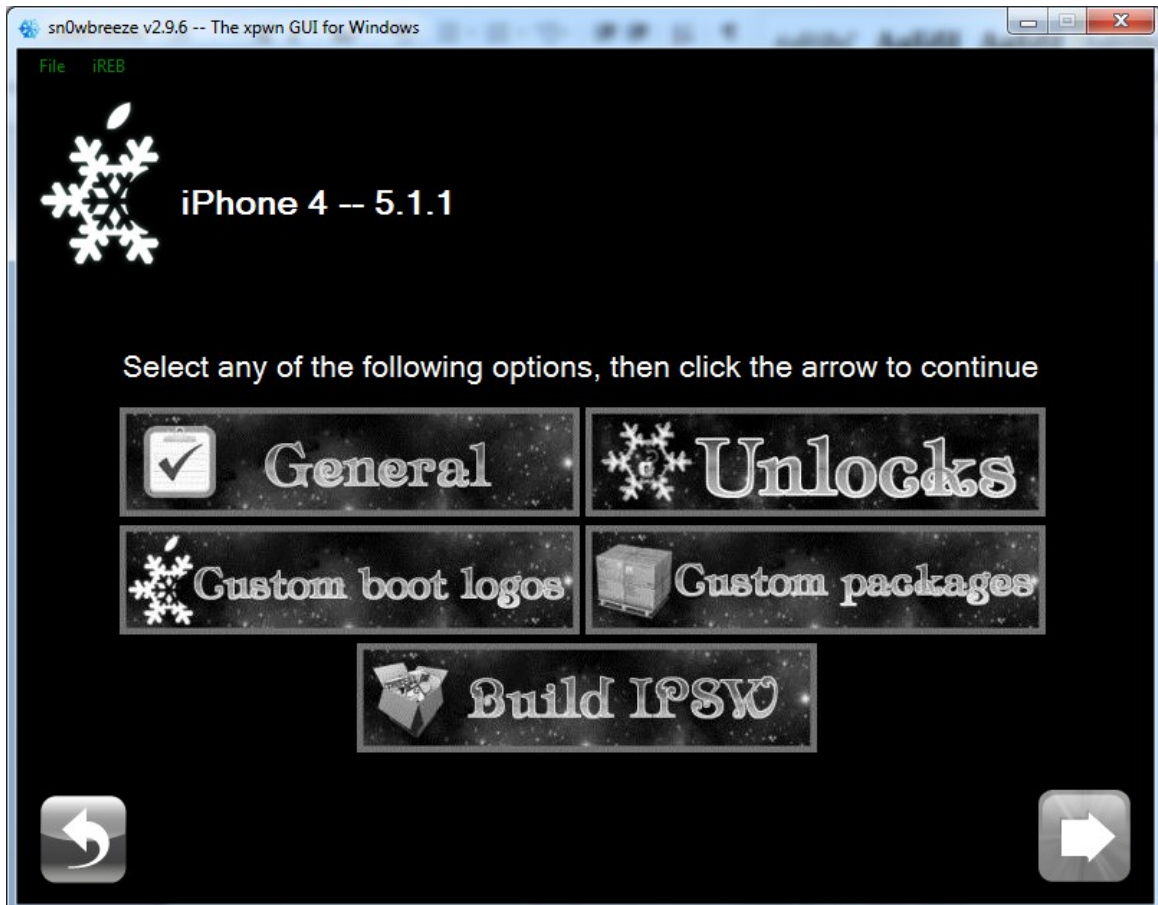
Select SHSH certificate for firmware 5.1.1 («XXXXXXXXX-iphone3,3-5.1.1.shsh»)

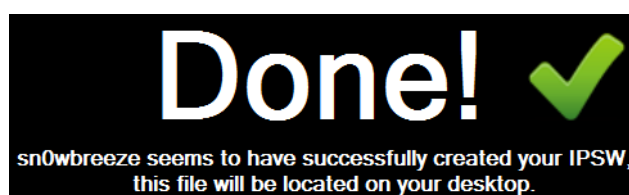




After processing, click **Build IPSW**

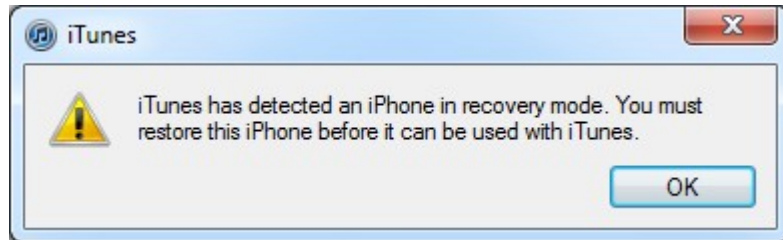


After creating the custom firmware (*from 3 to 10 minutes*), you need to enter your iPhone in **DFU mode**. Custom firmware is saved on the desktop.



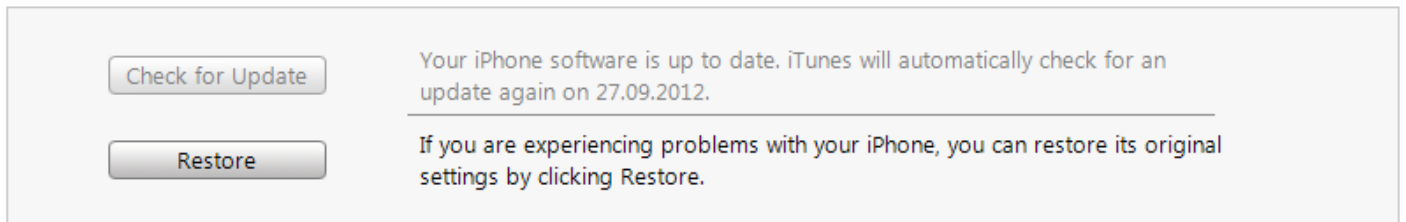
Step 3: Flash in iTunes

Enter **DFU mode**
Connect USB
Run **iTunes**



Now hold down **Shift** key and click the **Restore** button.
